- For part 61 training make sure you have all items listed completed: (61.109)
 - a. 40 hours total time.
 - b. 20 hours dual received.
 - c. 3 hours dual cross country training
 - d. 3 hours dual with sole reference to instruments.
 - e. 3 hours dual for night conditions with 10 take offs and landings to a full stop.
 - f. 1 dual night conditions cross country flight at least 100 mn in distance.
 - g. 3 solo take off and landings to a full stop at a tower controlled airport.
 - h. 1 solo cross country flight at least 150 mn total distance with at full stop landings at a

minimum of 3 points; one segment at least 50 nm (straight line distance) between take off and

landing locations from originating airport.

- i. 3 hours check ride preparation within 2 calendar months. (61.39)
- For part 141 training make sure you have all items completed: (appendix B to part 141)
 - a. Graduation certificate.
 - b. 35 hours total time and the experience requirements as stated above for part 61 training.
- Log book endorsements: Note, the language for the following 5 endorsements are from AC 61-65h.

Practical test 2 calendar month endorsement: 61.39(a)(6)(i) and (ii).
